❖ Objective

The objective of this agreement is to establish a mutually beneficial relationship between Chouksey Engineering College (hereafter referred to as CEC) and Hinduja Global Solutions Ltd [hereafter referred to as HGS] in the areas of academic, development and training of students under the Industry Institute Interaction Cell (IIIC).Areas of Cooperation.

❖ Principles of Cooperation

1. The cooperation is based on the principles of equal treatment and mutual benefit of both CEC and HGS, with their involvement respective to their capabilities.
2. Both parties will be able to use each other's logo/branding where needed for promotional purposes. Any use of a third-party logo/branding will require separate written authorization.
3. There are no financial conditions or liabilities involved in this MOU. Any specific financial terms and conditions for cooperation will be agreed upon separately, taking into consideration the financial capabilities of both CEC and HGS.



❖ **Duration and Termination**


1. This MOU Agreement is valid for a period of Five Years.
2. Each Party has the right to terminate the Agreement with a one-month notice period.

❖ **Miscellaneous**

1. Any changes to this Agreement must be made in writing.
2. Any disputes arising from this agreement shall be resolved through a conciliator appointed and accepted by both parties, and not through legal enforcement.
3. Both parties will maintain each other's standard levels and not involve each other in any kind of fraud, criminal, or unethical activities.
